Day 1 - 20 May Sydney to Macau

On arrival in Hong Kong you will transfer by ferry over to Macau.

Day 2 - 21 May G2E 2019 - Macau Show

Day 3 - 22 May Casino Visits - Macau

Day 4 - 23 May Macau to Bangkok

Depart Macau for Bangkok - transfer to Kanchanaburi.

Day 5 - 24 May Kanchanaburi

Today visit the Thailand-Burma Railway Centre which is an interactive museum, information & research facility dedicated to presenting the history of the Thailand-Burma Railway. Afterwards, we visit the nearby Kanchanaburi Allied War Cemetery.
INCLUSIONS: Thailand-Burma Railway Centre - Kanchanaburi Allied War Cemetery

Day 6 - 25 May Kanchanaburi

Today you will visit Hell Fire Pass & Memorial museum. This museum is a joint Australian/Thai project which is dedicated to those Australians & other Allied Prisoners of War & Asian laborer's who suffered & died at Hellfire Pass & elsewhere in the Asia Pacific region during WW2. There is also the Memorial Walking Trail, a 4km trail along the now peaceful & serene old railway track. Next visit the nearby Weary Dunlop Museum before driving back to Kanchanaburi where you will visit the Chong Kai Allied War Cemetery.
INCLUSIONS: Hell Fire Pass & Memorial museum - Memorial Walking Trail - Weary Dunlop Museum - Chong Kai Allied War Cemetery

Day 7 - 26 May Kanchanaburi

Enjoy a long-tail boat ride along MaeKlong River before boarding the death railway train, passing over the original wooden viaduct constructed by Allied POWs. You will have time to see the world-famous Bridge over the River Kwai.
INCLUSIONS: long-tail boat ride along MaeKlong River - journey on death railway train - Bridge over the River Kwai

Day 8 - 27 May Bangkok

A morning visit to the JEATH museum which documents the building of the railway by the allied POWs. After visiting the museum, you will depart Kanchanaburi for the drive back to Bangkok where you will be dropped at your hotel.
INCLUSIONS: JEATH museum - Return transfer to Bangkok - Overnight Bangkok Hotel

Day 9 - 28 May Bangkok to Singapore

This afternoon we will visit the Resorts World Sentosa; the country's first as well as biggest integrated resort. Along with its four world-class hotels, the Universal Studio that enthralles visitors with its movie-themed highlights & Marine Life Park - the world's largest oceanarium, Resorts World Sentosa is equally commendable for its casino; the first of its kind in Singapore.

Day 10 - 29 May Singapore

The first stop today is Changi Museum, dedicated to Singapore's history during the Second World War. Afterwards we will visit Johore Battery which was an artillery battery in Changi, Singapore. We will see Selarang Camp en route to Sembawang. Next, we will pass the Sembawang Park & Sembawang Shipyard. Onward to the Kranji War Memorial and Kranji War Cemetery, to pay our respects to more than 1100 Australian soldiers who are remembered in the British Commonwealth Memorial. After we will take a scenic drive towards the Civic Centre to visit the City Hall. While in the city, we will visit 2 memorials: Lim Bo Seng Memorial & the Cenotaph Memorial.
INCLUSIONS: Changi Museum - Johore Battery - Selarang Camp - Sembawang - Kranji War Memorial - City Hall - Lim Bo Seng Memorial - Cenotaph Memorial

Day 11 - 30 May Singapore to Darwin

Our first stop for the day is Reflections at Bukit Chandu. We will continue our journey to Labrador Park which besides its rich biodiversity, this headland played a significant role in the history of Singapore during World War II. Proceed thereafter to Fort Siloso, one of twelve coast artillery batteries which made up "Fortress Singapore" at the start of World War II. Our final stop today is St Andrew's Cathedral, the oldest Anglican house of worship in Singapore.
INCLUSIONS: Bukit Chandu - Labrador Park - Fort Siloso - St Andrews Cathedral

Day 12 - 31 May Darwin

Today we will tour some of the key historic sites of Darwin including Stokes Hill (a major target during the war), Fort Hill Wharf & World War 2 oil storage tunnels. We will also visit Christchurch Cathedral. We will then visit Snake Creek Explosives Storage Dump. Following this, we will head to Adelaide River War Cemetery.
INCLUSIONS: Key historic sites of Darwin including World War 2 oil storage tunnels - Christchurch Cathedral, WW2 airfields - Snake Creek Explosives Storage Dump - Adelaide River War Cemetery

Day 13 - 1 June Darwin to Sydney

This morning we will visit SkyCity Darwin Casino before heading to the airport for our afternoon flight home. With over 600 gaming machines to choose from, you'll find a full selection of your favorite games. Gaming machines are open 24 hours, 7 days a week. Table games on the main gaming floor are open from midday until 4am 7 days a week.
