- **Ozone – 118 floor @ Ritz Carlton TST**

Enter the magical blue-hued surroundings of OZONE, the most celebrated rooftop sky bar in Hong Kong, and let the city hold you in its mesmerizing spell. OZONE offers an ideal location for an unforgettable night, complete with a striking ambiance, inventive cocktails, delicious Asian tapas, and incomparable views from the highest bar in the world.

- **Sevva – Central**

The menu at SEVVA is inspired by the cultural diversity of Hong Kong itself: Authentic tastes typical of those created in everyday Chinese regional kitchens adding to the myriad of influences from the colonial days. The cuisine is fresh, simple, and honest, good food prepared on an emphasis of the finest produce: either from bustling local markets or flown-in (specialties) from around the world.

- **Sugar – Tai Kao**

- **Ho Lee Fook – Elgin St, Central. Aussie Chef/Owner – Jowett Yu**

Ho lee fook "good fortune for your mouth" is a funky Chinese kitchen inspired by old school Hong Kong cha chaan tengs and the spirit of late-night Chinatown hangouts in 1960's New York.

Taiwanese-born chef Jowett Yu's inventive approach to Chinese flavours is best enjoyed with an open mind and a strong appetite.

MACAU CASINOS – 13 TO 15 April 2018

After breakfast we will tour a casino tour of the Venetian Resort and then a visit to Old Macau taking in historical attractions like A-Ma Temple and the Ruins of St Paul—both UNESCO World Heritage Sites.

Casino Visits -

Lisboa - The Hotel Lisboa is a city within a city full of excitement and fun. Set up in 1970, the hotel is one of the most famous hotels in Macau. Known for its distinctive architectural design highlighting a lavish blend of Portuguese and Chinese décor with dazzling chandeliers and glittering mosaics, the hotel is an icon set within the heart of Macau. The hotel also highlights Dr Stanley Ho's extensive private collection of priceless art pieces.

MACAU – Latest Casinos

Melco Crown's Studio City Macau, which opened on October 27, 2015, features a 1,600-room hotel, a spa area with waterfalls and a sandy beach, the world's highest figure-8 Ferris wheel built right into the architecture between the two hotel towers, a Batman 4D flight simulation ride, an Ibiza nightclub called Pacha Macau, a 40,000-sq. ft. event Centre, a 40,000 sq. ft. Warner Bros. Fun Zone, 20 food and beverage outlets, MICE space, and of course, a casino. The casino has 250 gaming tables.

Following Studio City, Wynn Palace opened on August 22, 2016, and soon after Parisian Macau opened on September 13.

MGM Cotai and Grand Lisboa Palace, expected to open in 2017 and 2018 respectively. As of late 2016, there's been no word on when or if Wynn Diamond will open. The last mention from Steve Wynn was, "Phase two will be built at some point, maybe sooner than later."
